



BUILDING CAPACITY IN MONITORING, EVALUATION, AND LEARNING FOR THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

The USAID Monitoring, Evaluation, and Learning (MEL) Activity held a series of capacity building and gender integration sessions for staff at the Ministry of Education, which concluded with their development of a MEL plan. This training provided ministry staff with tools to monitor the new USAID Partnerships for Education award, which aims to improve access to and quality of education from kindergarten to tenth grade in Jordanian public schools and strengthening systems at the ministry, directorates and public schools. Developing the Ministry's MEL plan is part of the Partner Government Systems Agreement between USAID and the Government of Jordan.
