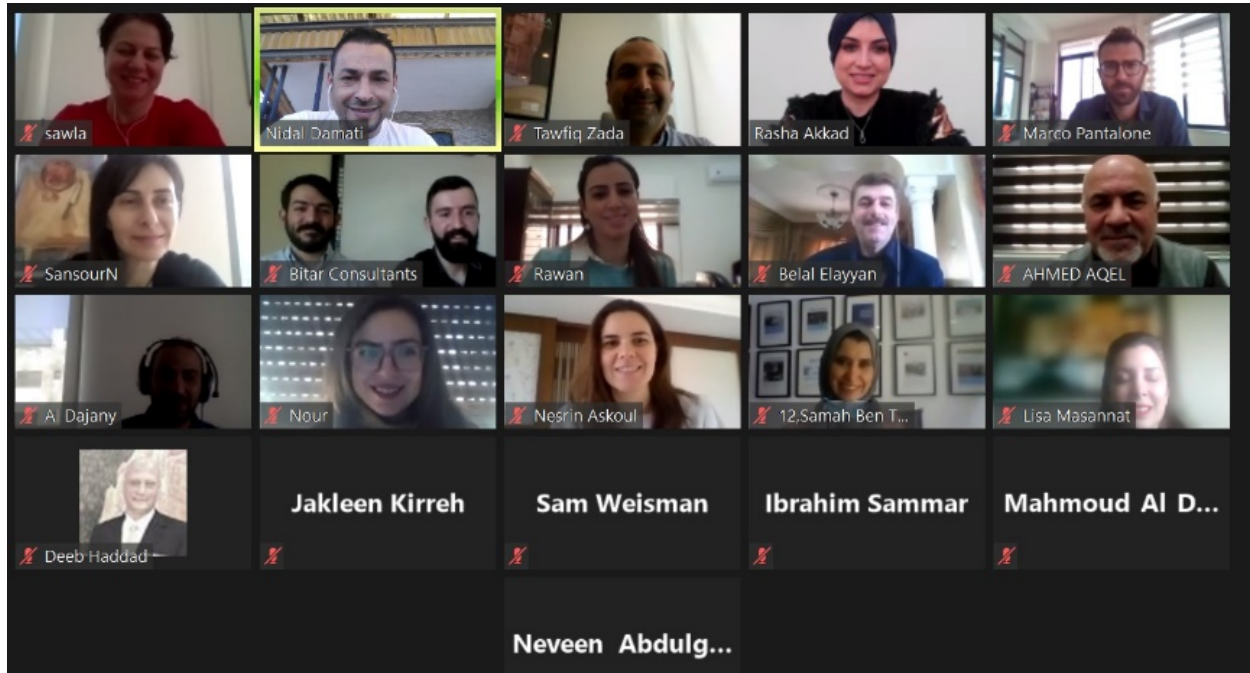


“Developing Activity Monitoring, Evaluation, and Learning Plans” Training for the USAID Mission and Implementing Partners Staff

The USAID Monitoring, Evaluation, and Learning Activity aims to improve the quality of monitoring, evaluation, and learning within USAID and its Implementing Partners. To address the priorities for capacity strengthening, which were determined by the Training Needs Assessment conducted in August 2020, the team developed and delivered a two-day Activity MEL Plan virtual training on April 5 and 6. A total of 20 participants attended the training, including implementing partners (MEL Specialists and technical staff) and Mission staff. Participants received an overview of MEL Plan components, including theory of change, log frame, and indicators, in addition to an overview of Performance Indicators Reference Sheets (PIRS). Implementing partners utilize the skills and tools acquired from the workshop when reporting on activity achievements and outcomes.
